

ESSA is seeking expressions of interests for one (1) expert/senior contributor with extensive experience in one or more of the domains of exercise and sports science to join the ESSA Publications Committee (EPC) for a term of up to 3 years beginning March 2024.

The Publications Committee oversees the development of ESSA endorsed, commissioned, or generated research publications, including position statements, consensus statements and guidelines, and collaborates with other organisations on the development of joint publications to assist with the translation and dissemination of exercise and sports science research for the benefit of ESSA professionals.

Expressions of interest are particularly encouraged from experienced research academics who are, or have been, members of a journal editorial committee relevant to exercise physiology, exercise science, or sports science and who are suitably skilled in research, publication, and practice.

Members of the Publications Committee will be appointed for a term of up to three (3) years. Members can renominate for the committee at the end of their term.

It is expected that members of the Publications Committee will attend one, 1.5 hour meeting bi-monthly, via teams scheduled at a time that will suit the majority of members; review publications in development; and contribute to the development and delivery of the annual work plan. Committee members are also expected to prepare for committee meetings in advance and are provided with material for review at least one week prior.
